*Applied subjects will only run if there are large enough numbers. These are subject to change up until September.



Students must be aged between 16 and 18 on 31 August 2019. Applications for students outside that age group will be considered according to the individual circumstances of the case; details should be supplied in writing to the Sixth Form office.

The minimum qualification for entry into the Sixth Form is 5 4 grades including Maths and English. There are specific entry requirements for some of our option subjects (see point i) onwards below). A student's suitability for their chosen subjects will also be taken into account, even if they meet the 5 4 grades threshold.

Final sixth form numbers will vary depending on combination of courses, availability of spaces.

Applicants will need to have a proven record of good or excellent effort, behaviour and attendance in Year 11 in order to qualify for a place, verified by a suitable reference.

- Applicants will be assessed on their estimated GCSE grades and a judgement will be made at interview.
- Students who meet our entry requirements will be invited for an interview where they can discuss their option choices
- All conditional offers will be made subject to adequate references. References will be sought for both internal and external students.
- For all sciences, a 7 in the relevant science, or at least a 7 in Additional Science, is required. At least a grade 5 in Maths is also required. A further entry test will be set in the first week of the course in September, this will be taken into account in assessing a student's suitability for the course.
- For the Applied Science course, a minimum of a 4 grade at GCSE science, core or triple, is required.
- For Mathematics, a minimum of a 7 at GCSE Mathematics is required. A further entry test will be set in the first week of the course in September, this will be taken into account in assessing a student's suitability for the course.
- For Further Mathematics, a minimum of a grade 8 at GCSE Mathematics is required, as well as evidence of success beyond GCSE. A further entry test will be set in the first week of the course in September, this will be taken into account in assessing a student's suitability for the course.
- For English literature and language, a minimum of a 6 in English is required.
- For Economics a minimum of a 5 in Maths is required.
- For Psychology and Geography, a minimum of a 5 in Maths and English is required.
- For Politics a minimum of a 6 in English is required.
- For RS, History, Sociology, Business, Film Studies a minimum of a 5 in English is required.
- For all creative subjects including Fine Art, D & T and Graphics a minimum of a 5 in another creative GCSE is required.
- For Computer science a minimum of a 5 in Maths is required.
- For Modern Foreign Languages the minimum entry requirement is a 5.
- For law the minimum entry requirement is a 6 in either English language or literature, but lower grades may be considered.
- A student who does not achieve a grade 4 in their Maths and/or their English GCSE will be required to re-sit these GCSEs as a condition of their offer. We recommend that students who achieve a grade 4 resit Maths or English to secure a grade 5 during their time at Sixth Form.
